
OVERVIEW

- The sources of information: ACODEV, CAFOMI, Caritas Tororo, CRS, KDLG, Save the Children, UN Women, UNICEF, URC
- As of May 28, 2020, **Fifty-three (53) districts** affected by the flash flood, the rise of water level of the three lakes and other water bodies, and landslide
- A total of **704,775** people in **151,990** households reported being affected by the disaster and its consequences
- 62,410** people in **12,462** families displaced from their home
- 2,896** of the affected population reported being people with special need
- Kasese is the most affected district, comprising **58% (409,735 people)**
- Bundibugyo, Bududa and Kisoro, the next most affected districts each with more than **30K** affected people
- The number of affected people in Notoko and Nakatpiripit each have more than **20K** affected communities.






